## Day Boys' Uniform List

### ALL CLOTHES AND SHOES MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED USING SEW ON WOVEN NAMETAPES

- Clothes should be marked with the child's full name.
- Shoes should be marked with the child's full name or school number.
- Rugby shirts, games shirts and tracksuit tops should be named across the top of the left shoulder on the outside.
- Shorts, tracksuit trousers and swimming trunks should be named on the outside of the waistband at the back.
- Please ensure all clothes are in good repair.

### Boys' Hair

- We would ask that you please keep to the traditional haircuts that are expected at The Chorister School.
- Boys' hair is expected to be neat, tidy and sensible. Hair must be cut above the collar, clear of the ears and the fringe should not fall over the eyes.
- **Not permitted:-**
  - Extreme haircuts, buzz cuts or dyed hair
  - Noticeably longer tops that are not layered in and combined with sharply contrasting sides and back, including any variation on a Mohican style (Mohawk)
  - Overgrown, heavy fringes brushed forward onto the face
  - High-top styles of excessive height or hair that is teased to give excessive height
  - Any type of line or pattern shaved into the head or eyebrows
